

Parents and students attending the Virtual Open House on April 19th were invited to write down their questions. Here are the questions and our responses.

What is the class size for grade one?

Once we know our enrolment numbers, we will have a better idea of what our class sizes will be. Our goal is always to have smaller class sizes in Kindergarten, Grades 1, 2 and 3.

Will there be supply lists?

Yes, we will be providing families with a list of classroom supplies. You should receive this with your registration confirmation at the end of May.

Should I invest in a notebook (computer) for my child?

That is not a requirement as the school will be providing netbooks and laptops for students to use; however, if you would like to purchase one, that would be your personal choice.

How will classes be assigned?

Based on student academic, social, behavioural and emotional needs, staff will collaborate and decide on the appropriate classroom assignment.

What kind of sports teams can we expect?

For our junior high students, we will be providing opportunities for students to participate in all the major sports. Depending on student interest and staff expertise, others may be added. For our elementary students, we will be providing intramurals and some after school activities.

How will special needs students be helped from Grade 1 – 6 (speech, language and motor)?

Based on student needs, Alberta Health Services will be able to provide speech and language as well as occupational therapy support to students with mild and moderate needs. For students with severe needs, Edmonton Public Consulting Services will provide support.

Will there be staggered entry for Kindergarten?

Yes. That information will be included with your registration confirmation in late May.
